

Box Hill at full Cry thanks to 14 medals

STEVE CRYER was shouting from the rooftops after Box Hill claimed 14 medals and 27 club records within a week at meets in Horsham and Swindon.

At the Atlantis Horsham event, 13-year-old Fergal Marrett raced to bests in all six of his outings, claiming silver in the 100m breaststroke and bronze in the 50 freestyle.

And in Wiltshire he smashed the club 200m

backstroke and grabbed another bronze. Another 13-year-old, team-mate Fin Ring-Hrubesh, sped to under three minutes in the 200m butterfly at Tigersharks to achieve a similar result.

Martha Hansford (10) took 10 seconds off her best but missed out on a regional qualifying time by a second.

Three bests for Eve Williams (13), in the 100m breast, 50m free and 100m free earned her a bronze,

while Felicity Everden (9), showed improved technique which allowed her to snatch two silvers and five club records across the two meets.

"I'm proud of all the swimmers and I've really enjoyed my first two months working with Conrad Cawley and the Box Hill team," enthused Cryer.

Other medallists included Florence Niemy, Jake Bedford, Sophia Hodgson and Isabelle Tinkler.
