

Cracking effort from Box Hill

BOX Hill swimmer Fin Ring-Hrubesh stormed to victory in the 50m freestyle at the Christmas Cracker Open in Horsham at the weekend.

The 11-year-old bagged gold and followed that up with a bronze in the 200m butterfly.

Georgia McGrath, also 11, fresh from her stunning medal haul at the recent Dorking Open, could only manage fourth position in the 50m breaststroke against some really tough opposition.

Another of Box Hill's fast improving 11-year-olds, Eve Williams took silver in the 50m freestyle and bronze in the 50m breaststroke.

Box Hill swimmers continue to collect 2010 county qualifying times under the direction of Owen Morgan.

George Gundry, yet another swimmer aged 11, came from nowhere in the Dorking meet to win gold and snatch a county qualifying time.

The team will now concentrate on building on their success at the Black Swan meet in early January.
